100	Nando Asti (Italy) 187ml	\$5
101	Mumm Napa Brut Prestige (California) 187ml	\$12
102	Mumm Napa Cuvee M (California) 750ml Marvelous. Magical. Magnificent. A creamy, slightly sweet release—perfect as an aperitif or with hors d'oeuvres, spicy asian-inspired foods or creamy desserts.	\$30
103	Castello Banfi Rosa Regale Brachetto (Italy) A slightly sweet, aromatic with a hint of rose petals and raspberries. This wine is fantastic with chocolate.	\$27

104	Mumm Napa Blanc De Blanc (California) Very clean and fresh, with aromas of citrus, honey and bread dough and flavors of orange marmalade, lemon curd and toast.	\$31
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WHITE WINES

201	Les Jamelles Chardonnay (France) Seductive scent of green apple, yellow pear and fine white flowers. On the palate, this wine flatters with a velvety soft texture and aromas of juicy pears, apple and pineapple.	\$15
203	Criss Cross Chardonnay (California) Has lively flavors of lemon pie and apples with a lingering, creamy finish.	\$18
204	Massey Dacta Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) The colour of freshly cut hay, with notes of pithy lemon and lime fresh off the homestead trees. Tropical getaway flavours of rock melon and passionfruit brought back to earth with lemongrass and a generous	\$18
205	Chignin by Charles Gonnet (France) Very pure, showing a melon rind edge to the green almond and light pear notes, with a refreshing finish. Jacquere alpine white grape, highly prized but traditionally hard to come by outside of France.	\$21
210	Richter Veldenzer Eisenberg Spatlese Riesling (Germany) Stunningly fresh and vibrant scents of grapefruit, cassis, white melon, herbs and spices.	\$22
206	Richter Classic Riesling (Germany) Delicate fruit, lively character, mineraly driven, yet dryish with crisp fruit acid; produced from 40 year old wines.	\$23
211	Richter Brauneberger Juffer Sonnenuhr Spatlese Riesling (Germany) Sensational, delivering beautiful aromas of peaches, lime, spicy florals, fresh ginger, honeysuckle and mineral notes.	\$25
208	Zepaltas Chardonnay (California) Creamy compartments of fig and walnut greet the palate on the entry of this crisp, well-composed Chardonnay, light in oak and bright in minerality.	\$28

- 209 **Orr Chenin Blanc (Washington)** \$28
Aromas of lime zest, pineapple, and honeydew melon. Lively, bright, precise and very dry, a tiny bit saline in the mouth with a hint of cucumber peel and wet sidewalk in the finish.
- 212 **Richter Brauneberger Auslese Riesling (Germany)** \$35
Apricot and orange zest plus a touch of honey and noble sweet botrytis. Rich and sleek. Fruit goes all the way to the back palate and goes on and on. Very viscous, delicate sweetness, but still a great balance through expressively clean and ripe fruit acid. Great as a dessert wine or with seafood, poultry, blue cheeses.
- “Red with meat, white with fish, except lox or herring. Rosé with any endangered species or an ice cream cone. Wine should be stored in a cool, dry place. The glove compartment of a Jaguar or an abandoned washing machine are my personal favorites. Good French wine should carry the phrase: ‘Mise en bouteilles au chateau.’ This assures you that only the owner of the vineyard has had a chance to tamper with the wine.”*

RED WINES

- 300 **Lulumi Pinot Noir (France)** \$15
Intense color with a precise bouquet of black cherry and raspberry. The palate is medium bodied with red berry fruit and an elegant, long finish.
- 301 **Gen 5 Zinfandel (California)** \$16
Lush and juicy with notes of spice and licorice.
- 302 **Gravennes Cote du Rhone (France)** \$17
Brilliant ruby color with powerful aromas of raspberry, tart cherry and black pepper. Balanced with just a touch of fine-grained tannin. A polished example of the Southern Rhone's varied terroir.
- 303 **Primary Wines Merlot (California)** \$18
Juicy California Merlot bursting flavors of blackberry jam and hints of vanilla and spice.

- 304 **Primary Wines Cabernet Sauvignon (California)** \$18
Full-bodied with aromas of cassis, dark plum, crushed berry and slight notes of dried herb and vanilla. Lingering fruit flavors carry through with mid weight tannins on the finish.
- 305 **Vina Galana Tempranillo (Spain)** \$18
Deep ruby color with aromas of raspberry, red cherry and licorice. Medium-bodied with finely structured tannins.
- 306 **Guido Barbera d'Asti (Italy)** \$19
Bright on the nose, with plenty of floral and ripe strawberry aromas. Notes of juicy fruit and summer berries with clean acidity and a subtle herbal finish.
- 308 **Antinori Santa Cristina Chianti (Italy)** \$21
Fresh and simple, showing clean berry and mineral character on a fruity, medium palate, with a crisp finish.
- 310 **Ruffino Lodola Nuova (Italy)** \$21
Inviting floral notes, with fruity scents of ripe plum and small red and black berry fruit.
- 311 **AIX Rosé (France)** \$23
The hypnotizing salmon pink color of AIX 2016 reveals the fruity freshness of top quality Provence rosé. Generous taste, harmonious structure and long finish!
- 312 **Chateau de la Terriere Brouilly (France)** \$23
Beautiful ruby color Beaujolais with a powerful and delicate bouquet of wild strawberries and raspberries. The silky tannins provide roundness and charm.
- 313 **Timbre Pinot Noir (California)** \$26
The nose exhibits red apples, dried leaves and raspberries. The palate boasts rich fruit, and is framed by soft tannins and balanced with acidity. Cola and strawberry preserves lead toward a finish highlighted by cocoa nibs, and caramel.
- 315 **Napa Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon (CA)** \$33
Beautiful nose with layers of berries, cocoa powder, with hints of clove and spice. Dark fruit, wild berries and cocoa flavors lead to a finish with well-integrated oak.

- 316 **Bruna Grimaldi Barolo Camilla (Italy)** \$31
Robust and full bodied, with intense perfumes, a long finish and a garnet red color with orange reflections.
- 317 **Domaine Vincent Girardin Corton Grand Cru - 2003 (France)** \$35
Medium ruby garnet color. Nose of cherry with touches of earth. A rich mouth feel, with chewy textures and a full rich mid-palate. Very seductive!
- 318 **Mauro Molino Barolo (Italy)** \$35
The 2008 Barolo is a pretty, entry-level wine graced with exquisite finesse in its sweet red berries, flowers and spices. This is a classic La Morra Barolo with tons of early appeal.
- 319 **Pierre Henri Morel Chateauneuf du Pape - 2009 (France)** \$35
The 2009 Chateauneuf du Pape has oodles of black raspberry and kirsch notes intermixed with roasted Provençal herbs, licorice, and spice box.
- 320 **Bruna Grimaldi Barolo Badarina (Italy)** \$40
Robust and full bodied, with intense perfumes, a long finish and a garnet red color with orange reflections. Aroma: Ample and intense with sensations of violet, pepper, raspberries and dried roses along with classic notes.
- 322 **Cabrieres Chateauneuf du Pape 2015 (France)** \$45
A blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mouvedre and Cinsault. The wine is lightly filtered and aged in used French oak barrels for 12 months before bottling. Cabrieres is best served with all types of classic meat dishes

PORT & SHERRY

- 400 **Warres Port LBV** \$30
Ruby color with a garnet rim. This Bottle Aged LBV shows mature red and dark fruits on the nose such as red cherries and floral notes of elderflowers. The palate is elegant and full of finesse with a backbone of freshness and flavors of red cherries and floral notes. The finish is long and lingering.

DESSERT WINES

- 401 **Alba Raspberry Wine** \$16
Produced entirely from red raspberries, fermented on the skins for twenty days to maximize the fresh berry character. It is finished sweet, with a slight tart edge to provide a rich berry experience without a cloying, syrupy finish.
- 402 **Mondavi Moscato D'Or (California)** \$17
seductively rich peach and lychee fruit, orange blossom, and jasmine aromas of this sweet wine.
- 404 **Wagner Vidal Ice Wine - 1999 (New York)** \$25
Ripe melon flavors; intense sweetness balanced by firm acidity with hints of peach and pineapple.
- 405 **Chapoutier Banyluls – 2004 (France)** \$26
100% black grenache with a deep garnet color. Aromas of dried fruits, red fruits, and cocoa, roasted coffee.

LIGHTER BEERS

- 500 **Anchor Steam (San Francisco)** \$3.25
Deep amber color, thick creamy head, and rich flavor.
- 501 **Paulaner Hefe Weiss (German)** \$2.75
Fruity aroma, with a creamy base and bready character. embodies just what a good hefeweizen should be.
- 502 **Flying Dog Doggie Style Pale Ale (Maryland)** \$2.75
Grassy, citrus, and slight perfume hop aromas with subtlety sweet malt body

ALES AND OTHER SPECIAL BEERS

- 504 **Abita Beer – Turbo Dog (Louisiana)** \$2.75
Rich body and color and a sweet chocolate toffee-like flavor.
- 505 **North Coast Brewing Company - Red Tail Ale (California)** \$2.75
An amber ale with a rich complex refreshing flavor and a crisp dry finish.
- 508 **Flying Dog St. Eadman Abby Ale (Maryland)** \$4.25
Dark Belgian Strong has bright fruity esters of pears and strawberries blending with caramel malt character and brown fruit notes of dried tart cherries and plums.
- 509 **Flying Dog Gonzo Imperial Porter** \$4.25
Roasted chocolate, coffee, vanilla malt flavors balanced with a unique hops bite.
- 511 **Ommegang Abbly Ale (New York)** \$4.50
Sip serenely as revelations of honey, toffee, chocolate and dark dried fruit delight your senses.
- 512 **Ommegang Three Philosophers (New York)** \$6.50
Luscious blend of rich malty ale and cherry lambic.
- 513 **Westmalle Tripel (Belgium)** \$8.50
A golden yellow Trappist beer with a fruity aroma and a nice nuanced hop scent. It is soft and creamy in the mouth, with a bitter touch carried by the fruity aroma.

- 515 **Trappistes Rochefort 10 (Belgium)** \$11.00
Dark brown color. Great strength balanced by a complexity of flavors and firm malt backbone. The bouquet covers a wide range: port wine, leather, apricots, oak, spices - a deeply intriguing beverage.

- 517 **Chimay Grand Reserve - 25 oz (Belgium)** \$19.00
Authentic Belgian beer, whose tinge of fresh yeast is associated with a light rosy flowery touch, is particularly pleasant.

- 518 **Ace Apple Cider – (California)** \$2.45
Has an apple nose and a clean, dry finish. It actually tastes similar to a Sauvignon Blanc. It's made out of 100% apple juice and is all natural, gluten-free, and low-calorie
- 519 **Ace Joker Apple Cider (California)** \$2.45
Made from 100% apple juice; it has champagne characteristics.
